NOXIOUS WEED CONTROL AGREEMENT

Initial to acknowledge and affirm each of the following statements: Minnesota Statute §18.78, Subd. 1, requires the following: A person owning land, a person occupying land, or a person responsible for the maintenance of public land shall control or eradicate all noxious weeds on the land at a time and in a manner ordered by an inspector or county-designated employee. Washington County Public Works, as the custodian of public lands adjacent to County Highways, is therefore required by state law to control or eradicate all noxious weeds within County Highway Right-of-Way. Methods used by Washington County Public Works to comply with this statute may include the use of chemical herbicides. Washington County Public Works is permitted under Minnesota Statute §18.78, Subd. 3, to enter into a Weed Control Agreement with a landowner to establish a mutually agreed-upon noxious weed management plan, thus transferring all responsibility for noxious weed management to the requestor for the duration of the agreement. By entering into this Noxious Weed Control Agreement, I affirm the following: I acknowledge that designated noxious weeds and control requirements are specified by the Minnesota Department of Agriculture and listed at http://www.mda.state.mn.us/weedcontrol. Paper copies are available upon request. I agree to assume all responsibility for control and eradication of all noxious weeds within County Highway Right-of-Way adjacent to the property described in this Noxious Weed Control Agreement application. I acknowledge that failure to comply with the Minnesota Noxious Weed Law (MN Statutes §18.75 – 18.91) may result in cancellation of this Noxious Weed Control Agreement and/or an enforcement action by local, county, or state officials. I acknowledge that this agreement will expire on December 31, 2022. The agreement may be renewed after expiration by submitting a new application to Washington County Public works for a Noxious Weed Control Agreement. Applicant Signature: _____ Date: _____
