## What happens next?

1



The sample gets tested.

3



If the result is **negative**, reduce your risk by practicing safer sex methods and be aware of potential STD symptoms. If the result is **positive**, we will discuss a treatment plan and send prescriptions to your preferred pharmacy.

2



You will be notified by phone with the results in a few days.

4



The prescription can be picked up and you can begin your treatment. We have the ability to treat your partner(s) as well, this is called expedited partner therapy (EPT). If you are participating in EPT, your partner(s) medications may also be filled and picked up for their treatment.
