Earn the Credits to Renew Your Minnesota Certified Food Manager Registration

The Washington County Department of Public Health & Environment invites you to discover what's going on with Food Safety in Minnesota. This course qualifies for continuing education credits (4 CEUs) to renew your Minnesota Certified Food Manager registration.

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Who needs a Certified Food Manager Certification?

Every food service establishment should have a Certified Food Manager. The CFM is required for most food establishments including full service and Deli/Fast Food/Coffee Shops. The CFM certification applies to the person, not the establishment. More than one manager or employee can be a CFM. Unsure if your establishment needs a Certified Food Manager? Contact your inspector at 651-430-6655.

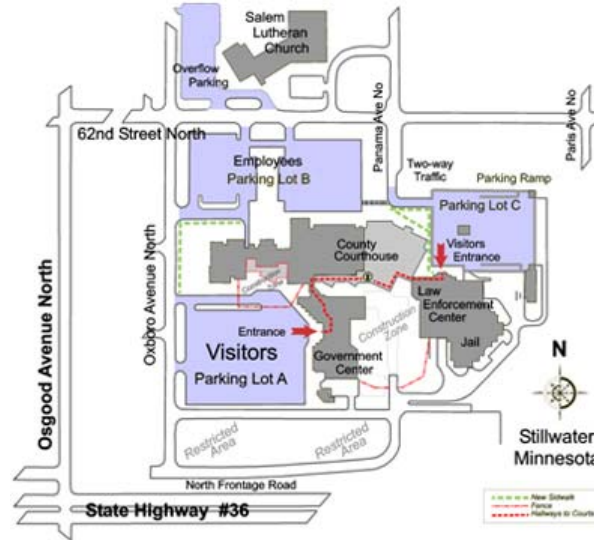
What should I do if I don't have my Certified Food Manager Certificate?

You will need to take a Food Safety Class and pass the test to apply for the certification. Classes and applications can be found at the Minnesota Department of Health's website at: <http://www.health.state.mn.us/divs/eh/food/cfm/index.html>

What should I do if my Certified Food Manager Certificate is expired?

If your Certified Food Manager certificate is expired less than 12 months, you are able to take a refresher course and renew your CFM with the Minnesota Department of Health. If it is lapsed more than 12 months, you will need to retake a full Food Safety Class and reapply for the CFM.

Directions to Washington County Government Center 14949 62nd Street North Stillwater MN 55082

Take State Highway #36 to its intersection with Fourth Street (Osgood Avenue North).

Make a left turn and go north on Fourth Street to 62nd Street North.

Make a right turn onto 62nd Street North and proceed one block east.

The Washington County Government Center will be on your right.

At this point, make a right turn onto Oxboro Avenue North and proceed south to Visitor Parking Lot A.

LL14 is located on the Lower Level, one floor below the entry; the stairs are located as you enter the Government Center front doors. The elevator is located to the left as you enter.
