In Minnesota, any minor (person under 18) may give effective consent for medical, mental and other health services to determine the presence of or to treat pregnancy and conditions associated there with, birth control, venereal disease, alcohol and other drug abuse, and the consent of no other person is required (Minnesota Statute 144.343)

The Minnesota Family Planning Program is available to many low income Minnesota men and women. This program provides free family planning services including yearly exams and birth control at most clinics. Ask any clinic about the qualifications for this program.
